### **HUBCAP**

Working with Urban Innovations 21, Urban Redevelopment Authority City of Pittsburgh, and Design Center to explore a creative industries corridor for the Northside.

### **Charm Bracelet II**

Partnering with the Education Committee of the Northside Leadership Conference in convening STEAM arts and culture and creative industries opportunities with Northside schools to pursue a "Magnet Community". Implementing this year with First Graders and the Children's Museum, Second Grade with the Aviary, Third Grade with Carnegie Library, Fourth Grade with the Carnegie Science Center and its Fab Lab, 5<sup>th</sup> Grade and Manchester Craftsman's Guild, Middle Schools with the Warhol and Mattress Factory and High School with Steeltown Entertainment.

### **Northside Corps**

Exploring the potential of stipends for Northside residents to work on One Northside initiatives through AmeriCorps and other stipend-based models.

### **Allegheny Commons Park**

Supporting the Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy's efforts to continue improving the park system and networking with potential partners such as ALCOSAN.

### **Food Program**

Working with the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank, FOCUS, PPS and other corporations to develop a weekly "Backpack" program. Program in all Northside Public Schools and serving more than 2000 kids every Friday..

### **Faith-based Community**

The Pittsburgh Theology Seminary is interviewing all institutions of faith to determine how best to engage them in the One Northside Plan.



## **Buhl Community Projects**

### **After-School Network**

Working with APOSTE and PPS focused on building an after-school support system for every 12 to 18 year-old in the Northside. Network has met a number of times and is committed to addressing transportation, staff training, parental support, fund development and work-skill preparation.

### **Northside Trail System**

Working in partnership with G-TECH to build a trail system that connects Northside neighborhoods. Over the summer a team of graduate students from Chatham University School of Sustainability, Penn State School of Architecture and Design and Carnegie Mellon University canvassed all Northside neighborhoods to identify more than 1500 community assets.

### **Early Childhood Delivery System**

Working with the One Northside Action Team on Day Care and Family Care Providers, Pennsylvania Association for the Education of Young Children (PAEYC), PPS, and Northside providers to begin examining how to support the early childhood development system that incorporates home-based child care, day care centers and pre-k preparation and education that are both community and school based.

### **Anti-Litter Collaborative**

In partnership with the One Northside Anti-Litter Action Team, Pennsylvania Resource Council and PA Cleanways, launching an anti-litter campaign, piloting a recycling program, and organizing neighborhood cleanup groups and dump site cleanup days.

### **Public School Principal Support**

Northside Principals are meeting to develop a strategy for supporting individual schools and initiatives that support all public school youth.

### **Youth Employment**

In Partnership with the One Northside Employer Action Team, Northshore/Northside Chamber of Commerce, and the Three Rivers Workforce Investment Board seeking to connect 100 youth aged 16 to 18 to existing job vacancies among Northside Employers.



## **Buhl Community Projects**

### **Entrepreneurship**

New Sun Rising and Riverside Center for Innovation are conducting entrepreneurship training in Northside neighborhoods. The program is scheduled to begin in the new year.

### **Diversion Program**

Working in partnership with the Northside Fair Housing Coalition and City of Pittsburgh Policy Zone 1 to pursue a diversion program allowing young men and women who have committed first-time, low-level, non-violent crimes to opt into a transition plan with case management rather than arrest and potential incarceration.

### **Mixed Income Housing**

The Design Center conducted three Knowledge Sessions regarding affordable housing and vacant property in the Northside. Secured a Pulse Fellow at Design Center to research mixed income models to inform Northside housing work.

### **Business Community**

Working with One Northside to convene employers about the One Northside Consensus Plan, employment supply and demand needs in the Northside, and opportunities for engagement.
